Dr. Dharmendra Saraswat is an Associate Professor in the Agricultural and Biological Engineering Department at Purdue University. He and his team have been engaged in conducting research on the use of information and communication technologies (ICTs) for plant production (field and nursery crops) and natural resources management, spatial and temporal modeling for watersheds and development of sensor-based farm data analytics and management framework. Dr. Saraswat's recent efforts are aimed towards extracting information from big data in agriculture through development of new curriculum and web tools. He is internationally and nationally recognized for his research and extension efforts in agricultural engineering. He is a three-time winner of ASABE Educational Aids Blue Ribbon award, and many others.
